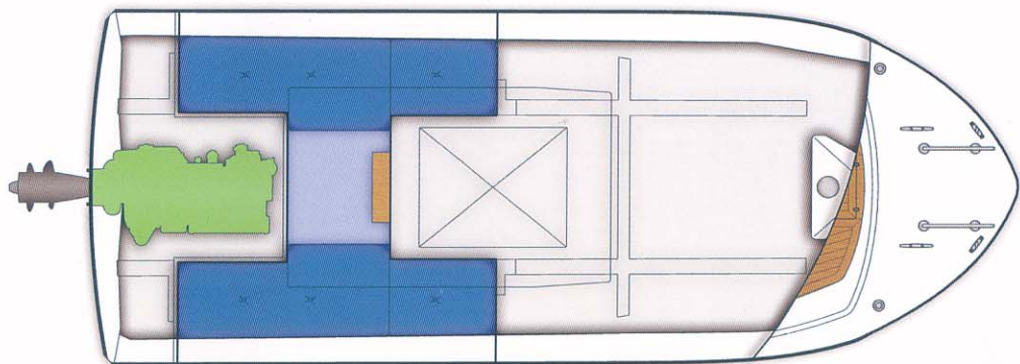
For a small boat the Targa 23 offers a lot of features normally only found on bigger boats. Careful attention to design ensures both handling characteristics and available space are excellent. As with all Targa boats safety is first rate, noticeable on deck from the location of grab handles and the high gunwales. The Targa 23 is a fast boat suitable for those who appreciate good performance at sea.

- Fore and aft self draining decks
- Swimming platform including ladder
- Wide passageways around pilothouse
- Seven seats on deck
- Pilothouse with two sliding doors
- U-shaped front seat with storage lockers
- Seat behind pilothouse
- Five seats in pilothouse
- Two pipe berths in aft cabin
